Results show the views of 150 professionals who identify as working for organizations that provide treatment for behavioral health, mental health and substance use disorders, all of whom shared an outlook on the state of the behavioral health industry in the year ahead.

Staffing will be a significant pain point in 2023. More than half of providers cited staffing as the biggest challenge to the behavioral health industry in 2023. Additionally, nearly 80% of respondents indicated that staffing changes will also be the greatest area of financial strain in the behavioral health industry for 2023.



Telehealth will play a significant role in behavioral health care delivery.



What is the biggest challenge to the behavioral health industry in 2023?




How do you expect telehealth use in behavioral health will change in 2023 relative to 2022?




What digital health tool are you most excited about in 2023?


When it comes to digital health tools, more than half of survey participants are most excited about telehealth in 2023



What is the greatest area of financial strain the behavioral health industry will face in 2023?




What is the greatest opportunity for the behavioral health industry in 2023?




Where will behavioral health providers see the greatest growth in 2023?

Behavioral health providers expect to see the greatest growth in partnerships during 2023




Where do you anticipate referral growth will be greatest in 2023?
